Companies with a need for highly qualified personnel in research, development, and engineering, as well as **non-university research institutions** (with a scientific-technological focus).
Small, medium and large companies (micro-enterprises excluded)
- What is the amount of funding?
Up to EUR 50,000, de minimis aid
Funding rate: 50 – 70 %
- How long do projects last?
From six to 24 months

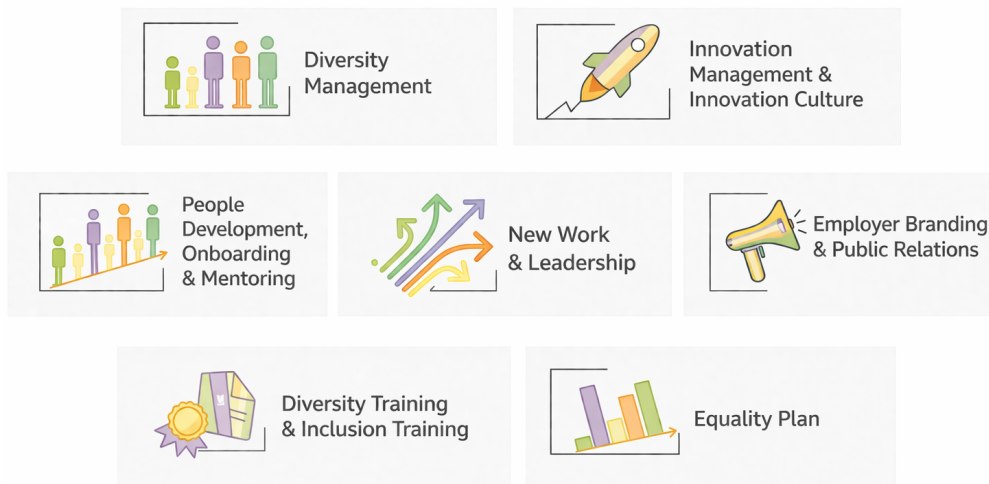
