Aims of the training

This interactive 1 ½ day training will prepare you for writing a competitive proposal for an IF. We will explore the structure of the proposal using practical examples and interactive exercises. There will also be room to reflect on your own project idea. The on-site training at FFG will be complemented by short e-learning inputs before and after the training.
