FEMALE DOCTORAL CANDITATES FOR ENERGY TRANSITION, MOBILITY TRANSITION OR CIRCULAR ECONOMY

The Federal Ministry for Climate Action, Environment, Energy, Mobility, Innovation and Technology (BMK) supports career opportunities for women in natural sciences and technology with the call "Dissertantinnen für Zukunftsthemen der Wirtschaft 2023".

The call is open for **female doctoral candidates** with a research focus in the call topics: **energy transition, mobility transition or circular economy.** 



The doctoral candidates work in a company or a non-university research institution and deal with scientific or technical research questions within energy transition, mobility transition or circular economy as part of their doctoral thesis. The doctoral candidates are supervised at a university with the right to award doctorates.



The company or the non-university research institution is the applicant within the call and the recipient of the funding. The **funding amounts to a maximum of 50% of the total eligible costs** or a **maximum of EUR 110,000 per project**.

## **Current Call:**

**Call period**: August 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023 until funds are exhausted or November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at the latest.

The submission is possible on an **on-going basis**.

**Budget:** EUR 2 million in total – split for the three call topics
