REMEMBER THE PURPOSE OF AN ITN

- to train a new generation of creative, entrepreneurial and innovative <u>early-stage researchers able to face current and future challenges</u> and to convert knowledge and ideas into products and services for economic and social benefit
- to raise excellence and structure research and doctoral training, <u>extending the traditional academic research training setting</u>, incorporating the elements of Open Science and equipping researchers with the <u>right combination of research-related and transferable</u> <u>competences</u>
- to <u>provide enhanced career perspectives</u> in both the academic and nonacademic sectors through international, interdisciplinary and intersectoral mobility combined with an innovation-oriented mind-set

KEY ASPECTS FOR THE TRAINING

- To <u>increase the employability</u> of the researchers: the research training should be complemented by the meaningful <u>exposure of each researcher to the non-academic</u> sector.
- Substantial training modules, including digital ones, addressing <u>key transferable skills</u> common to all <u>fields</u> and fostering the culture of Open Science, innovation and entrepreneurship
- In view of Open Science as new modus operandi of research: training should <u>prepare</u> <u>ESRs for an increased research collaboration and information-sharing made possible by new (digital) technologies (e.g. collaborative tools, opening access to publications and to research data, FAIR data management, public engagement and citizen science, etc)</u>


BUDGET - SOME NOTES

- Budget calculation as usual (ie country correction coefficient applied to living allowance and in relation to the country of recruitment; project budget for family allowance for 50% of the researchers; redistribution of institutional unit costs among organisations is possible; budget flexibility for using institutional units)
- Mind the requirement of full-time employment
 → check if you need matching funds for employment costs to meet real staff costs

- Mobility allowance for <u>private</u> mobility
- Family allowance meant "to reduce family related obstacles to researcher mobility"
- Visa / residency card for the ESRs from the RTN budget (all entry visa for ESR and his/her family), even if before recruitment, and also for secondments

RESUBMISSION OR NEW PROJECT?

- Y/N question in form A "Resubmission" if the proposal or a very similar one have been submitted to the ITN Calls 2018 or 2019
- What is a "very similar proposal"? → the previous proposal differs from the current one <u>in minor</u> <u>ways</u> from the consortium composition and scientific point of view
- Why this question? Relevant for evaluation procedure: no comparison of projects, but Vicechair receives previous ESR at the end of the consensus phase



"The Vice-Chair in charge of following the evaluation of your current proposal will receive a copy of the previous Evaluation Summary Report29 at the end of the consensus phase (i.e. after the agreement of the experts on the comments and scores). However, please note that the evaluation of the current proposal will submission(s). There will be no comparison between proposals."

 - b) current involvement in ITN
 - c) similar proposals under ITN call 2020?
 - Mind the wording: "relevant actions/projects"

 Institutional Commitment letter "to indicate commitment to award a degree from all participating organisations awarding a degree (irrespectively if beneficiary / partner)
- GfA and template part B include templates for both types of letters (annex 6a, 6b)
- Integrate letters into B2, section 7, mind the max. size per file (10 MB)
