- **European Digital Identity and Trust Ecosystem (Standards and Sample Implementation) – 2nd work strand (Call 6)**
Type of action: Simple grant
Beneficiaries: Private persons, private companies, public bodies, EDIC
- **Innovative and Connected Public Administrations (Call 6)**
Type of action: Coordination and support action
Beneficiaries: National, regional and local authorities as well as other relevant private and public organisations or any other organisation participating in digital government transformation and interoperability activities
- **European Digital Media Observatory (Call 7)**
Type of action: SME support grant
