OBJECTIVES

The Spin-off Fellowship programme is designed to **develop the intellectual property** held in Austrian universities and research institutions so that it can form the basis for **new start-ups**.

The research institution has to be the owner of the existing IP.

During the entire project the Fellow has to be employed by the research institution.

During the term of the project the fellow(s) (= potential founders) must **devote themselves exclusively to the project**, and may not carry out any teaching or other research assignments during that period.

Those who opt for a fellowship are choosing to follow a new career path, and moving away from a scientific career at a university or research institution!



FORMAL CRITERIA

- The technologies or research results are the property of an organisation which is eligible to apply.
- There is a declaration of support from the research institution
- There is a letter of recommendation from the host (e.g. Head of Department)
- The fellow(s) are in an employment relationship with the university or research institution when the project starts.
- There is an **individual IP commercialisation agreement**, based on the spin-off strategy of the relevant university or research institution.



OVERVIEW

Fellow is the "project leader"

Individual Fellow or a team

What is the duration of the Fellowship?

min. 12 months – max. 18 months

How high is the funding?

max. € 500.000,- per Fellowship as 100% grant
